This Addendum Number 5 shall be part of the Request for Proposals No. 2021-16 for Contract No. 6-Facility Improvements, Fire Protection at the Materials Recovery Facility (the "MRF") in Hillburn, New York issued by the Rockland County Solid Waste Management Authority d/b/a Rockland Green (hereinafter "Rockland Green") on July 30, 2021, and as amended (the "RFP").

This Addendum Number 5 provides Rockland Green's responses to following list of clarification questions received from potential Proposers in connection with the RFP.

(Terms used but not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning set forth in the RFP)

- Question No. 1:** E-001 mentions that the Electrical Contractor is to furnish duct and unit smoke detectors, but would this not be part of Contract #6? Please confirm.
Response No. 1: Duct and unit smoke detectors are part of Contract No. 6.
- Question No. 2:** Is EMT conduit acceptable or is rigid conduit required?
Response No. 2: Refer to Appendix B to the RFP, Specification, Section 284621.11, paragraph 3.5 for installation requirements.

Question No. 3: Does the existing fire alarm system need to remain while new construction is going on? Can we demo during construction?

Response No. 3: Refer to Appendix B to the RFP, Specifications, Section 284621.11, paragraph 3.2

Question No. 4: Does the conduit need to be painted red?

Response No. 4: No.

Question No. 5: In order to provide the last three years of financial statements as part of the Proposal, our company will need the attached Nondisclosure Agreement signed.

Response No. 5: Rockland Green will not sign a Nondisclosure Agreement. Instead, please refer to Article X, Terms and Conditions of Procurement, Section (b), Confidential/Trade Secret Information of the RFP, which explains that should a Proposer's submission to the RFP contain "trade secrets," or other information that the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to be harmful to business interests, Proposers must ensure that such information is clearly identified and marked as such. Marked information will be treated as Confidential Third Party Information.

Rockland Green is subject to New York State's Freedom of Information Law (NY CLS Pub O §§ 84-90) ("FOIL"). Should marked information be the subject of a request under FOIL, Proposers may be requested to either consent to the request, or make a representation explaining why the information should not be disclosed.
